SANTA ROSA, CA (November 4, 2025): The Redwood Empire Food Bank (REFB) is partnering with Redwood Credit Union (RCU) and A Simple Gesture to simplify holiday giving for our community. Donors in Sonoma County and throughout the North Bay can help address growing food insecurity by leaving shelf-stable food on their doorsteps for volunteer pickup.

This convenient food drive, running through December 19, responds to the urgent need as local families and individuals face rising food insecurity and essential services experience ongoing funding challenges.

Community members are encouraged to sign up through our dedicated Redwood Empire Food Bank holiday food drive link: refb.org/asg. Registered donors will simply leave a bag of nonperishable food items on their doorstep on the two designated pickup days—Saturday, November 8, and Saturday, December 13. Donations will be collected and delivered to the Redwood Empire Food Bank, where food will be distributed to families in Sonoma, Lake, Mendocino, Humboldt, and Del Norte counties.
